
*Free yourselves from spoon-feeding culture: Simai to youths



Speaking to the editor, Chahum Bo, a graduate from Khonsa and Peyir Ngomdir, class-XII passed from Aulo, both GDA pass out, said that the course would help them to take selfcare, the family and the society. This is perhaps the 6th nursing school in the state, but first in eastern Arumachal that too in this remote corner, which would serve as a boon for aspiring students to undergo this professional but demanding training, he said. Simai, who distributed certificates to 50 women who have completed six-month general duty assistance (GDA) course, said that the GoAP has been trying to identify and channelise the hidden talents of state youths to skill them to become part of nation building process as envisioned by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. He exhorted the MNS trained nurses to break the NE boundaries to serve the rest of India and reiterated that five zonal hospitals, including the Khonsa one, would be strengthened with equipments and manpower to serve the purpose. The GoAP will set up skill university soon to skill the unskilled youth, he said and exhorted the youths to develop positive mentality to come out of spoon-feeding culture. He lauded the UD department for offering its building to run the MNS. Conceived as a pilot project in 2010; the MNS has so far trained 300 women in general duty assistance (GDA), basic massing course, said Bethl Lifecture Charitable Trust (BLCT) chairman Chandan Prasad adding it has been affiliated by the Indian Nursing Council with 20 ANM seats of four-semester The MNS with highly experienced principal Forene Baila, having worked with CMC Vellore, would provide quality training, h said, adding that the BLCT empanelled by Union Ministry of Skill Development, has so far has provided IT training to 700 youth under Prdhan Mantri Kaushak Vikahs Yojana (PMKVY) while the GDA course will be given free to those below class-XII pass. 
